
Intensive Hands-on course on BSL3 training, biosafety practices and TB research protocols

The program will be conducted for various government and private institutions for skill development and quality manpower for working in containment facilities and for using pathogenic *M. tuberculosis*.

Hands-on and classroom sessions on the following topics-

- Review of biosafety principles and levels
- Waste management
- Safety procedures and Emergency management
- BSL-3 laboratory practices
- Biosafety cabinet practices and procedures
- Small and large spill decontamination
- Donning and doffing PPE
- Laboratory operations and preventative maintenance
- Data and material management
- Culturing of M. tuberculosis
- Glycerol stock preparation of M. tuberculosis.
- M. tuberculosis stock CFU determination.
- gDNA/lysate preparation from M. tuberculosis culture
- Electroporation of M. tuberculosis cells.
- · Aerosol infection of animals and administration of drugs.

This course is designed for researchers who want to conduct research with Risk Group (RG) 3 infectious agents, such as *Mycobacterium tuberculosis* or any other requiring BSL-3 containment. Previous BSL-3 experience or RG2 infectious agent experience is highly recommended.
